



Call for Proposals and Expression of Interest from Consultants:

CCEDU recognizes the previous and current deficits in the election administration and management to include; weak independent oversight of election exercise, a disengaging electorate and weak legislative and policy framework for managing and conducting elections. It is expected that through the proposed media messaging campaign CCEDU will continue to enhance sustained citizen commitment towards active, informed and meaningful citizen participation in electoral processes while contributing to its long-term goal of promoting inclusive and participatory democracy in Uganda.

CCEDU is therefore inviting M & E Consultants/firms to submit proposals on developing M,E and Learning tools to track progress towards achieving outcomes and goals set out under the theme Increasing transparency, integrity, accountability and citizen participation in Uganda's electoral process.
