



Call for Proposals

Analyst

The Foundation for Human Rights Initiative/ Citizen's Coalition for Electoral Democracy in Uganda (CCEDU) is seeking for the services of an Analyst in democracy and governance. The analyst will be responsible for analyzing data collected and writing a report following the fact finding mission on the local Council (LC) I & II Elections held on July 10, 2018.

The election follows government decision to hold the local council election by lining. The Parliament of Uganda passed the Local Government (Amendment) Bill, 2014 providing for lining up behind candidates during elections of chairpersons for village (LC1) and parish (LC2) levels. The voting method brought in effect by the Bill was a departure from what was originally provided for in the Local Government Act, of universal adult suffrage through secret ballot.

FHRI/CCEDU appreciates the need to hold these elections given the pivotal role LC1 play in the community but does not agree with the proposed methodology of lining up. In effect, FHRI went court challenging the methodology though never got chance for the case to be cause listed before the election date.

As part of gathering evidence for the legal team in the case, CCEDU/ FHRI mounted a fact finding mission in all the 12 electoral regions in Uganda. The teams were on ground from the 25th of June to 15th 2018. The teams were able to observe all aspects of the pre-election, election and post-election period and the findings will be the basis for the analysis with the view of compiling information that will support the litigation process.
