Reference: Documentary on the LCI & II Election

Citizens' Coalition for Electoral Democracy in Uganda (CCEDU) is a consortium of about 972 civil society organizations and over 27,000 individual members established on August 19th 2009. Since inception, CCEDU has been the leading civil society actor in Uganda in advocating for electoral reforms, monitoring electoral processes and conducting voter mobilization/education campaigns.

CCEDU is calling for expressions of interest from reputable organizations/individuals/firms to assist in the production of a high quality (Full HD), forty five minute, documentary film following the recently concluded LCI & II elections. The election follows government decision to hold the local council election by lining behind the preferred candidate. The Parliament of Uganda passed the Local Government (Amendment) Bill, 2014 providing for lining up behind candidates during elections of chairpersons for village (LC1) and parish (LC2) levels. The voting method brought in effect by the Bill was a departure from what was originally provided for in the Local Government Act, of universal adult suffrage through secret ballot.

The documentary should highlight all aspects of the election right from the pre-election period through to the post-election period. CCEDU has sourced for the video footage from which the documentary will be developed. Besides the video footage, the successful bidder will be required to hold interviews with key stakeholders in the electoral process in the past years with the view of capturing their views especially on the open ballot system.

The final output from the successful bidder could be used as part of gathering evidence for the legal team in the case, for the FHRI/CCEDU case which is right now before the constitutional court of Uganda
