Citizens' Coalition for Electoral Democracy in Uganda (CCEDU) is a consortium of about 972 civil society organizations and over 27,000 individual members established on August 19th 2009. Since inception, CCEDU has been the leading civil society actor in Uganda in advocating for electoral reforms, monitoring electoral processes and conducting voter mobilization/education campaigns.

The Parliament of Uganda passed the Local Government (Amendment) Bill, 2014 providing for lining up behind candidates during elections of chairpersons for village (LC1) and parish (LC2) levels. The voting method brought in effect by the Bill was a departure from what was originally provided for in the Local Government Act, of universal adult suffrage through secret ballot.

CCEDU is calling for expressions of interest from reputable organizations/individuals/firms to collect and provide high quality (Full HD) video footage following the recently concluded LCI & II elections. The election follows government decision to hold the local council election by lining behind the preferred candidate. The footage that will consequently be used in the production of a documentary should highlight all aspects of the election right from the pre-election period through to the post-election period.

The successful bidder will be required to provide the final output in an editable format preferably Mp4 format stored on a either an external Hard Drive or DVD Discs and delivered to the CCEDU offices.
